
Common Irregular Verbs

Verbs change spelling to show tense.

Regular verbs change spelling according to the pattern shown below:



Irregular verbs do not change spelling according to a pattern, so each one must be memorized. Here is a list of common irregular verbs in their present-tense, past-tense, and past-participle forms. The past participle is used with helping verb *has, have, or had* to form the perfect tenses.
