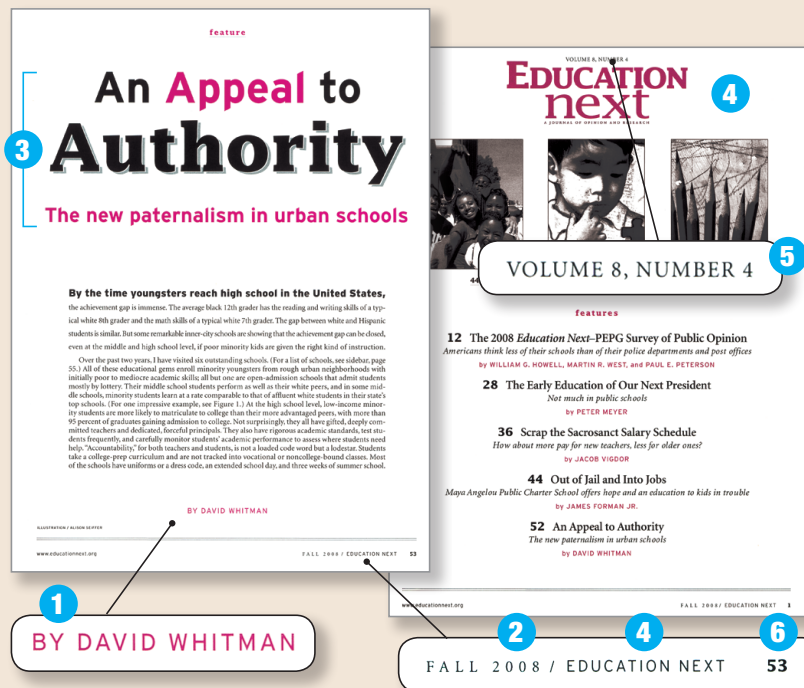


Citation at a glance | Article in a periodical (APA)

To cite an article in a print periodical in APA style, include the following elements:

- 1 Author
- 2 Year of publication
- 3 Title of article
- 4 Name of periodical
- 5 Volume number; issue number, if required
- 6 Page numbers of article
