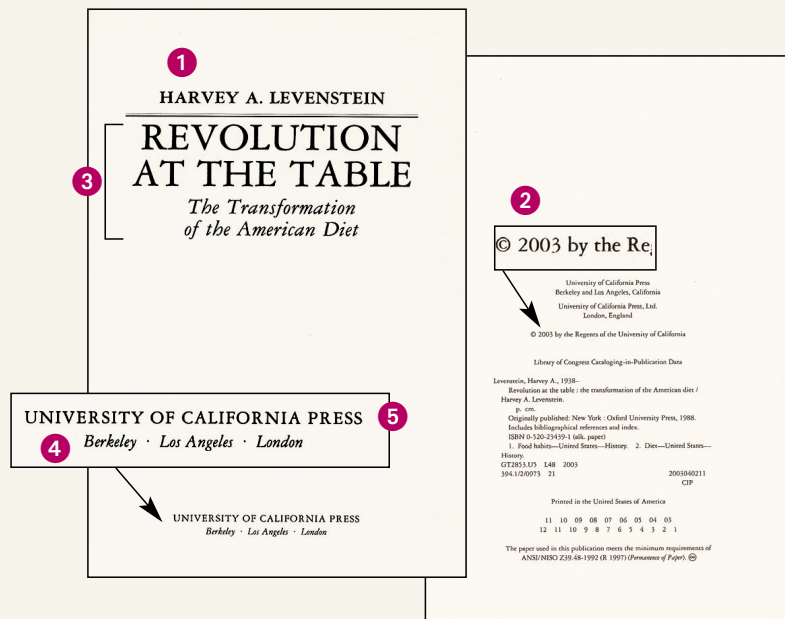


Citation at a glance: Book (APA)

- 1 Author
- 2 Date of publication
- 3 Title and subtitle
- 4 City of publication
- 5 Publisher
