- 1 Author(s)
- 2 Year of publication for journal; complete date for magazine or newspaper
- 3 Title and subtitle of article
- 4 Name of periodical
- 5 Volume number; issue number, if required
- 6 Page number(s)
- 7 DOI (digital object identifier)
- 8 URL for periodical's home page (if there is no DOI)
