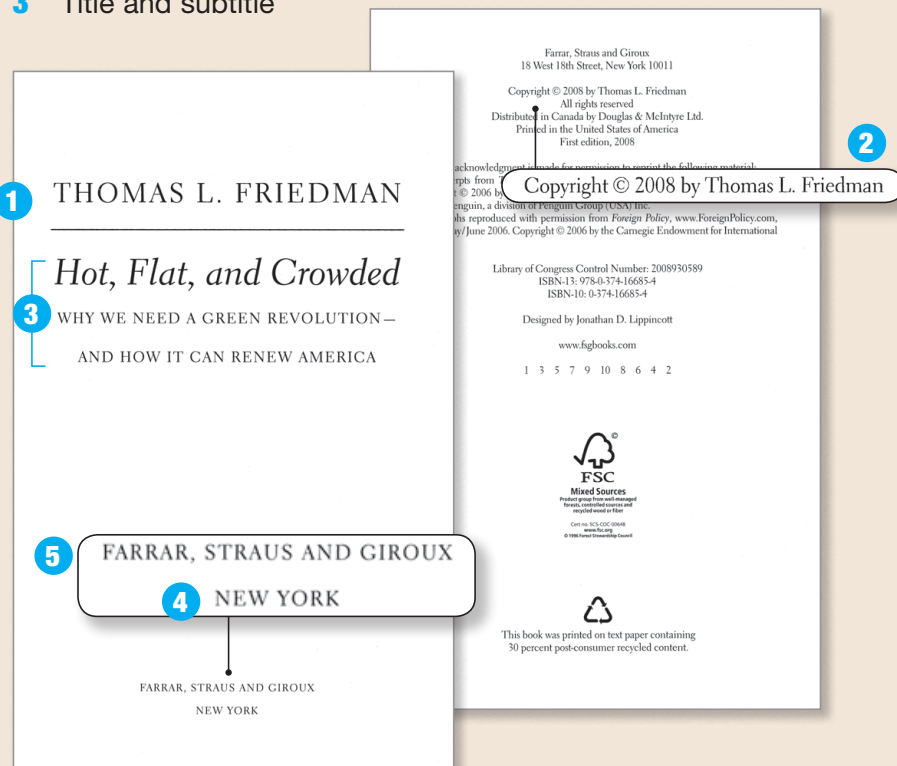


## Citation at a glance | Book (APA)

- 1 Author
- 2 Year of publication
- 3 Title and subtitle
- 4 Place of publication
- 5 Publisher
