
## **Citation at a glance** | Primary source from a Web site (*Chicago*)

To cite a primary source (or any other document) from a Web site in *Chicago* (CMS) style, include as many of the following elements as are available:

- 1 Author
- 2 Title of document
- 3 Title of site
- 4 Sponsor of site
- 5 Publication date or modified date; date of access if none
- 6 URL
