

How to Identify Run-on Sentences and Comma Splices

QUESTIONS

1. Does the sentence have two or more independent clauses?

REVISION STRATEGIES

It is not a run-on or a comma splice.

2. Are the clauses joined by a comma and a coordinating conjunction (*and, or, nor, but, for, so, or yet*)?

The sentence is not a run-on or a comma splice.

3. Are the clauses joined by a semicolon (;)?

YES

The sentence is not a run-on or a comma splice.

4. Are the clauses connected with only a comma?

YES

The sentence is a comma splice. Revise.

5. Does the sentence lack both a comma and a coordinating conjunction?

It is a run-on sentence. Revise.
